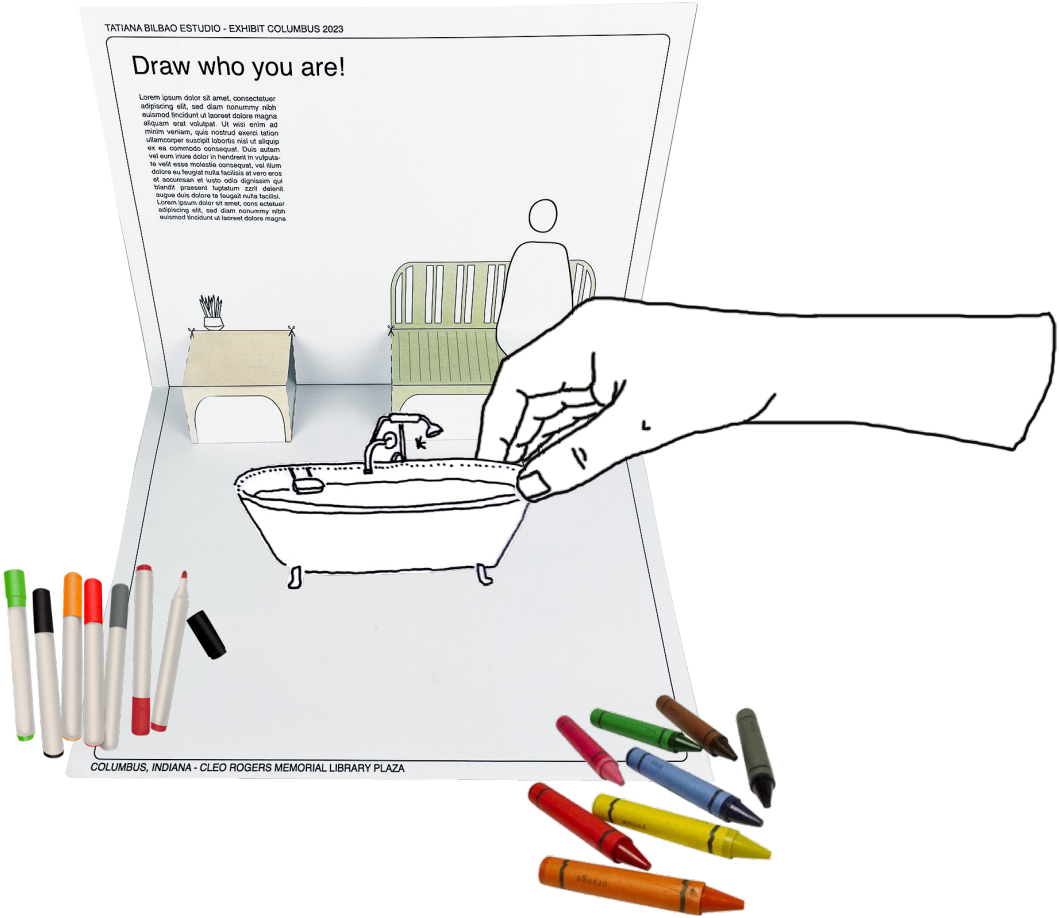
This cycle of Exhibit Columbus celebrates creative methods of collaboration trough which communities and designers can work together to cultivate belonging and connection in public space.

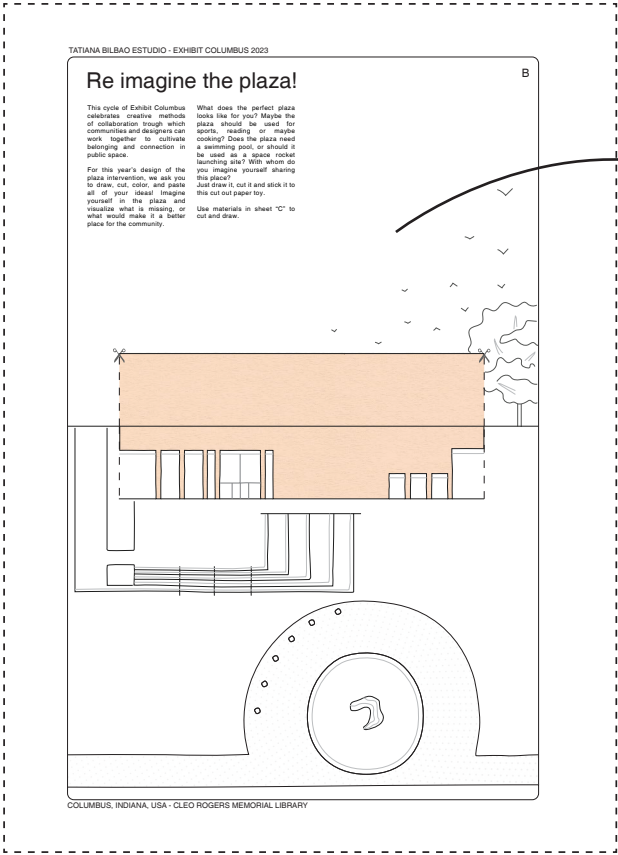

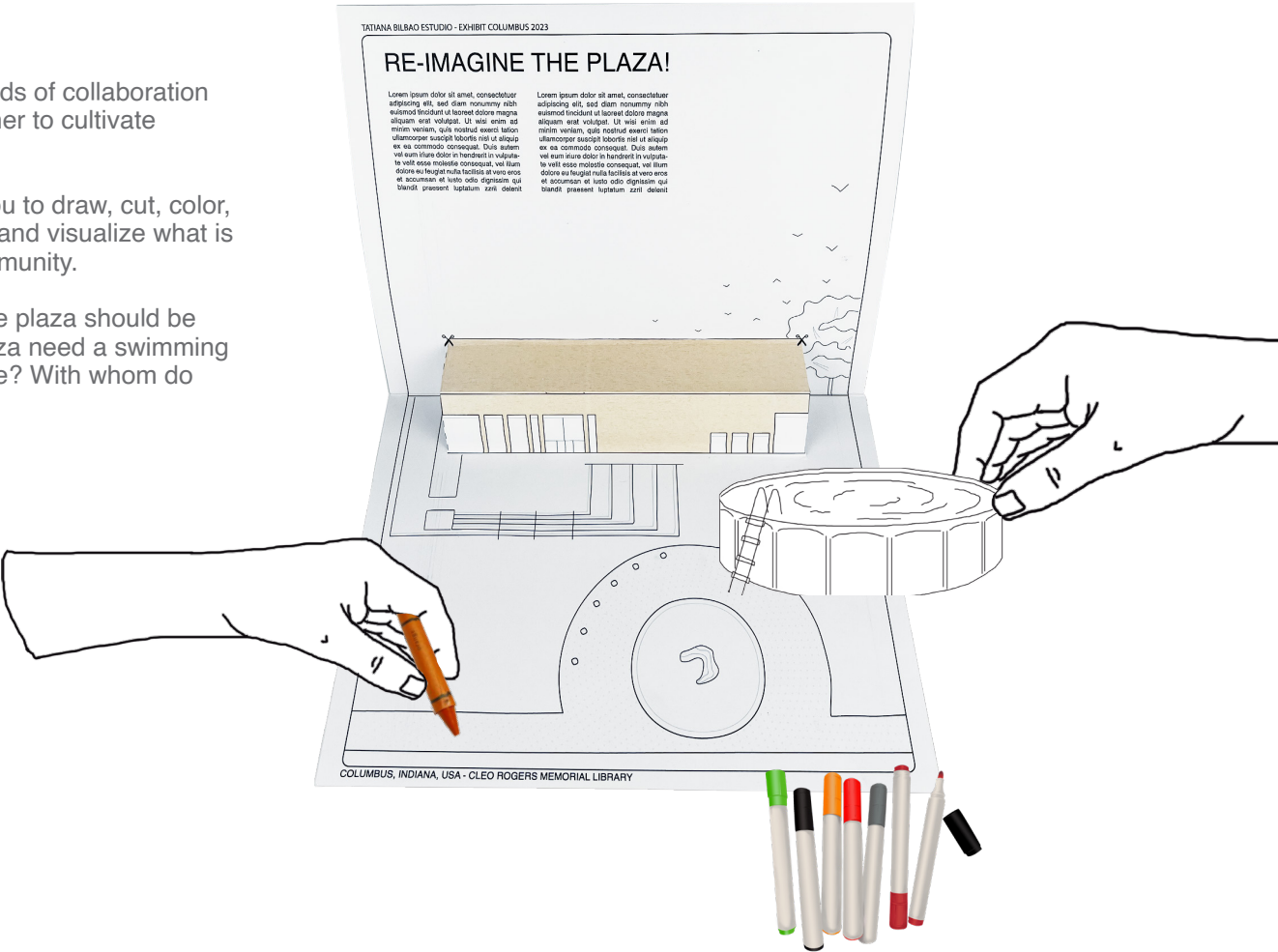
This cycle of Exhibit Columbus celebrates creative methods of collaboration trough which communities and designers can work together to cultivate belonging and connection in public space.

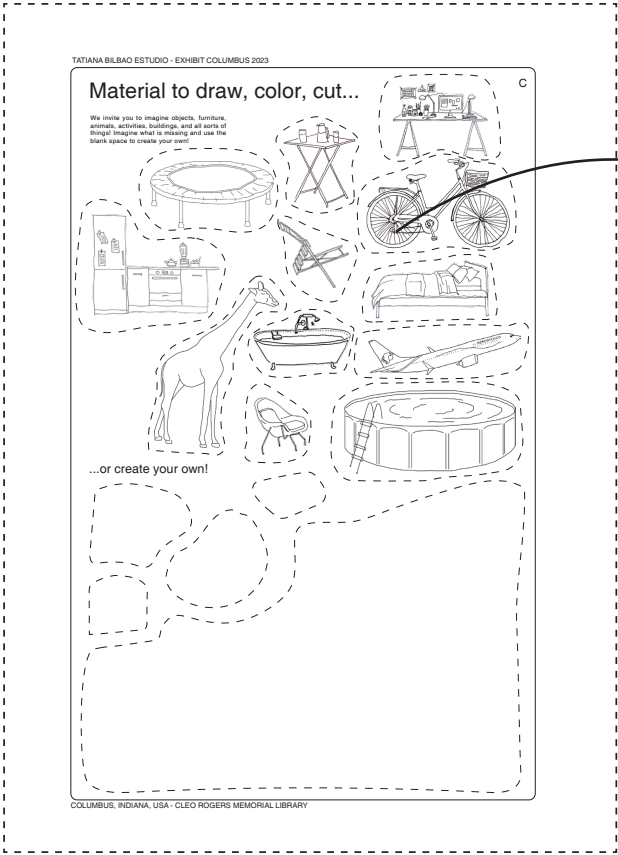

Use materials in sheet “C” to cut and draw.



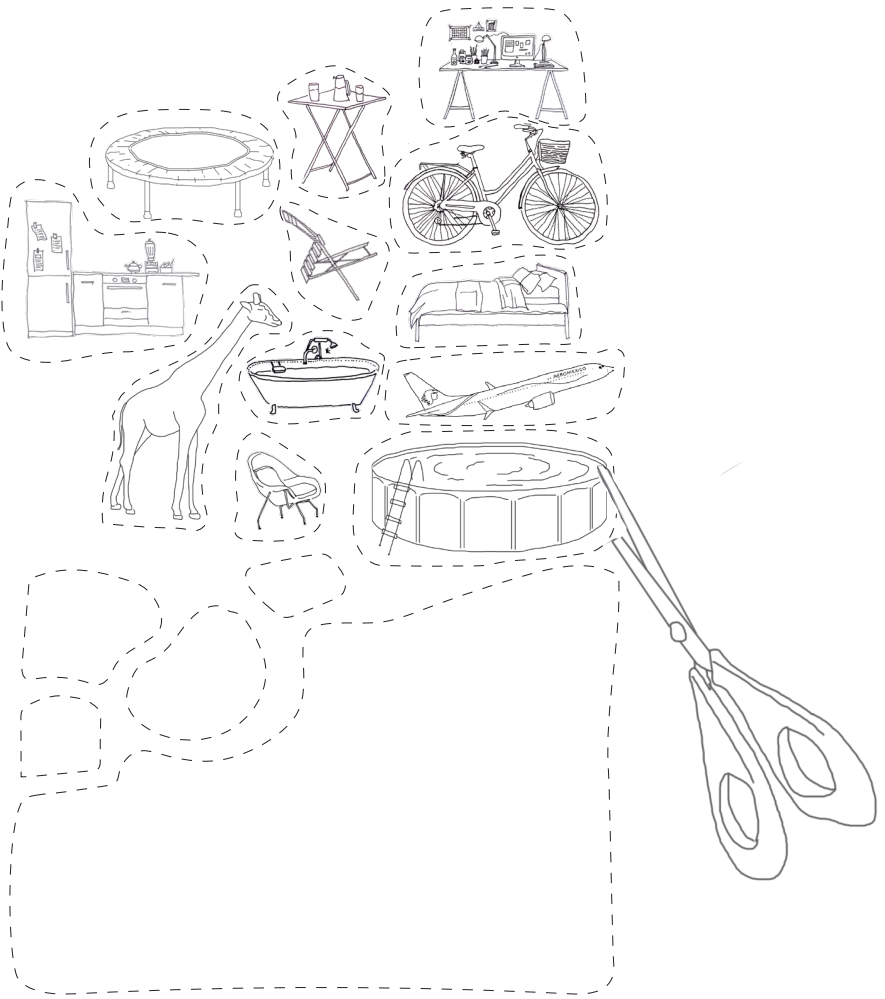
